All tickets, coupons, and orders are furnished and issued subject in all respects to the foregoing and to any and all terms and conditions under which the means of transportation and/or other services provided thereby are offered and/or supplied. The Tour Operator, ITC Tours, reserves the right at its discretion, to change or alter any part of the itinerary, hotel accommodations or aircraft equipment, without notice. The right is reserved to decline or accept or retain at any time, any person as a participant in any tour, or to cancel any tour, unless arrangements are made at the time of booking. The Schedules and Itinerary contained herein are subject to change without notice. All rates are based on current Tariffs and Exchange rates (\$1.00 US equals \$1.30 Euro) in effect at the time of printing of the tour folder and are subject to adjustment without notification in the event of changes therein. Airfare at time of printing is \$1100.00 includes all current taxes and fees and subject to change.

TOUR PRICE: Based on a minimum of 40 people traveling together. An increase may be necessary if this number is not obtained the passage contracts in use by the transportation companies concerned, when issued, shall constitute the sole contract between the transportation companies and the purchaser of these tours and/or passenger. The airline(s) providing transportation are not to be held responsible for any act, omission, or event during the time that passengers are not on board their aircraft or conveyances. In the event the air carrier with whom the chartering organization has a contract to perform the air transportation described is delayed in performance or unable to perform with such aircraft, the provision of the relevant Civil Aeronautics Board's Economic Regulations and/or relevant IATA/ARC regulations shall govern the right and obligation of the parties.

CANCELLATION: All monies (less \$300.00 handling fee) will be refunded if cancellation is received 120 days prior to departure. Between 120-30 days forfeiture of \$400.00 deposit, plus any liquidating charges imposed by the hotels, buses and airlines will be charged. 29 days prior to departure no refund on entire package unless a replacement can be found. All cancellations must be received in writing.

OPTIONAL TRIP CANCELLATION WAIVER COVERAGE: The total benefit for any Insured Person is limited to an amount equal to the Insured Person's tour cost. In the event a person is prevented from participating in all or part of a covered trip due to accident bodily injury, death or sickness to himself, a traveling companion or immediate family member (which required the care and attendance of a physician) or other unforeseen circumstances outside the person's control, ITC Tours will reimburse the person for: A) the non-refundable, prepaid travel expenses (transportations, accommodations and other services) due to cancellation of the trip prior to the originally scheduled departure; or B) if interruption occurs after departure, the unused non-refundable, prepaid travel expenses and C) the additional travel expenses incurred up to the cost of economy air fare required to return to the original point of departure or to rejoin the original trip for which the Insured was booked. Any such additional travel expenses; however, will be reduced by an indemnity paid for unused transportation under (B) above. All refunds are subject to a \$300.00 per person handling fee. Exclusions: Payments will not be made for common carrier caused delays or cancellations, change of plans, financial circumstances, business or contractual obligations, government regulations and pre-existing medical conditions. 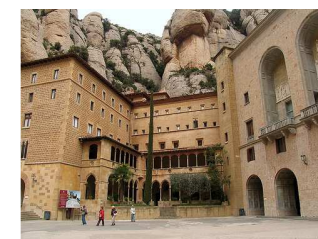

ITINERARY

Day 1 Sunday Aug. 7th Anchorage / Frankfurt
Depart Anchorage for our overnight flight to Frankfurt.

Day 2 Monday Aug. 8th Frankfurt / Lourdes
Depart Frankfurt Airport for Lourdes. Overnight in route. (D)

Day 3 Tuesday Aug. 9th Lourdes
Mass will be celebrated on our arrival in Lourdes. Evening participate in the candlelight procession. Overnight in Lourdes. (CB,D)

Day 4 Wednesday Aug. 10th Lourdes
During our stay in Lourdes, we will visit the historical and spiritual sites associated with St. Bernadette, the visionary child of Lourdes, born on January 7, 1844 to Francois and Louise Soubirous. We begin with a walking tour visiting the Basilica of St. Pius X, the world's largest underground Church, Boly Mill, Soubirous family home, the Basilica of the Rosary, miraculous spring and the healing baths. Afternoon is dedicated to a group retreat reflecting on the life of St. Bernadette. (CB,D)



Day 5 Thursday Aug. 11th Lourdes / Barcelona

Depart Lourdes and cross the border into Spain. Early afternoon arrival in Barcelona. After dinner a lovely Barcelona by night tour. We will visit the Tibidabo Hill that offers a beautiful panorama of Barcelona, the harbor and one of the world's most famous water fountains. (B, D)

Day 6 Friday Aug. 12th Barcelona / Montserrat / Barcelona

Today a beautiful drive to the Montserrat Monastery. The history of Montserrat begins in the 9th Century with the arrival of Benedictines from Ripoll. In 1811 disaster befell, the Monastery was sacked by the French. The present buildings, therefore are 19th Century, at the end of the dark, over ornate Church candles burn ceaselessly before the sanctuary to the Virgin. The Black Madonna is a polychrome wood statue said to date from the 12th Century; the seated figure of the Infant Jesus was restored in the 19th Century. The statue is venerated annually by thousands of pilgrims as the Patron of Catalonia. The Escolania, one of Europe's oldest boys' choirs, its beginning dates back to the 13th Century, can be heard daily at the Monastery. Celebrate mass in Montserrat. Early afternoon departure for Barcelona with a stop to visit the Cathedral. The present Cathedral, built to replace a Romanesque Church, was begun at the end of the 13th Century and completed in 1450. Next we visit the Sagrada Familia Church. Dinner and overnight will be in Barcelona (B, D)

Day 7 Saturday Aug. 13th Barcelona / Zaragoza

We depart Barcelona for Zaragoza. We will visit the Shrine of Our Lady of the Pillar, the second most popular pilgrimage site in Spain. The magnificent alter in the Basilica built on the site where the Blessed Virgin Mary appeared to the Apostle St. James before her Assumption into heaven. We see the Chapel of the Virgin, Assumption of the Virgin marble statue and other numerous chapels and artworks inside the Basilica. Mass celebrated at the basilica. Dinner and overnight in Zaragoza. (CB,D)

Day 8 Sunday Aug. 14th Zaragoza / Toledo / Madrid

Depart Zaragoza for Toledo the capital of Castile. We will visit the Cathedral, view El Greco masterpiece in the Chapel of Santo Tome. Mass will be celebrated at the cathedral. Continue to Madrid. (CB,D)



Days 9 – 15 Monday thru Sunday August 15th – 21st World Youth Day Activities

Attend World Youth Day activities. Continental breakfast daily at housing site (CB) and dinner at housing site on August 21 (D). WYD meal will include lunch and dinner. (L,D) WYD meal schedule to be advised.

Days 15 – 16 Sunday & Monday August 21st – 22nd Madrid / Frankfurt

Early evening on August 21st we begin our journey to the Frankfurt airport. Overnight in-route to Frankfurt on August 21st and 22nd. (CB,D)
